### GALLERY OPENING OF THE WEEK

In celebration of the 50th anniversary of Jamaican independence, the Art Museum of the Americas has organized a group exhibition of Jamaican photographers and video artists in its satellite F Street Gallery. On Wednesday from 6 p.m., the

gallery will host an opening reception for "Outward Reach: Seven Jamaican Photographers and New Media Artists."

The strange title is an allusion to the Jamaican diaspora. All of these Jamaican-born contemporary artists — Jacqueline Bishop, Kerry-Ann Brown-Louis, Andrea Chung, Jodie Lyn-Kee-Chow, Tal

Rickards, Radcliffe Royce and Cosmo Whyte — remain rooted in their country of origin, even while living and working in the United States.
